



# Why Let a Good Buy Go Bye-Bye?

I am sure everyone has noticed the great change in how our beloved R.S. Prussia is sold today. We too have to change if we expect to add that hidden treasure to our collection.

One new concept of marketing of R.S. Prussia, which is changing how auctioneers do business, is the growth of internet auctions. These auctions can open a whole new world right in our homes.

With the increasing use of internet auctions, we must change in order to reap its benefits! If you do not, you only limit yourself in your search of that piece you have been looking for. These internet auctions

make it extremely easy for us to travel to a far distant auction that we could never have gone to in our cars.

Distance, our health, traveling costs or other obligations are no longer reasons for missing a R.S. Prussia auction with internet connections. The fear of buying an item that you have not inspected will always be there. But, this fear can be limited if you do your homework. The internet auction provides you with many beautiful pictures and descriptions, but do not be afraid to ask for additional pictures or ask in-depth questions. If you still are in doubt, pick up the phone



and talk to the auctioneer (please do this several days before the auction). If you still have doubts about the item or the auctioneer, I would recommend that you do not bid or keep asking questions until you are free of doubt.

I have been going to the Woody Auctions for almost twenty years and still enjoy them today as much as I did that first auction I attended. John and Jason Woody use Proxibid.com as their internet partner. Since I usually go to all of the Woody Auctions (usually to be with my friends), I have seen how the internet has helped the Woody Auction sales grow. Over the last two years, the Woody internet bids and sales have gone from not much to an impressive force.

At Woody's last auction, I carefully monitored bids placed with Proxibid.com and was amazed at the high dollar volume of bidding that was transacted over the internet. This only tells me that more and more collectors are becoming comfortable using the internet to bid.

I like to use sites like Proxibid.com and Icollector.com to find R.S. Prussia sales. By checking these sites and others, you can find some very lucrative purchases. One time I was able to buy a vase for \$70 which six months later was sold for \$2,700. Last September, I made an incredible find and buy using an internet auction in partnership with Pacific Galleries in Seattle, Washington.

If it wasn't for the internet, I would never have known about the items to be auctioned. The 25 plus items (please view the 3 pictures) that I got in 12 different lots was a dream come true! To see the items better, go to e-Bay and do a search for #230171882588, then on the right side of description and click onto Next Lot> to see the other 13 lots.

The 12 lots were a collection of Green Peacock Tiffany Finish in mint pristine condition with some minor wear. I did my homework



with many phone calls to answer my questions. Arrangements were made for the auction company to call me a few minutes before these items were to be auctioned (I also viewed it on the internet) so I could place my bid by phone. When these

items started to be auctioned, I could not believe how cheaply they were being sold.

If you have not viewed an internet auction, take a look and see if it might be for you.

If the abundance of marks and varieties that one encounters in collecting R. S. Prussia isn't challenging enough, then the great variety of E. S. marks and styles will prove to be highly gratifying. E. S. china, which refers to Erdman Schlegelmilch porcelain, was manufactured from 1861 through 1935, and encompasses a wide variety of decors, numerous markings, and items ranging from simple utilitarian shapes and designs to elaborate gilded and jeweled pieces that command high prices and great collector interest.

This seminar was originally presented in 2004, and was updated and augmented with new photos for the 2007 Peoria convention. The seminar's objectives were to provide a comprehensive history of the porcelain, describe and show many of the marks, and to show a wide representation of E. S. and related wares. I addressed the relationship of E. S. porcelain to R. S. Prussia. The E. S. factory in Suhl, Prussia, was originally a forge, established in 1811. In 1861, it was converted to a porcelain factory by three brothers – Leonhard, Carl August and Friedrich Wilhelm Schlegelmilch. They named the factory in honor of their father, Erdman, who established the forge. This was the first known porcelain factory in Suhl. Eight years later, in 1869, Reinhold Schlegelmilch opened the R. S. factory. Reinhold was not closely related (if at all) to

the E. S. family. However, these two factories produced beautiful porcelain that has worldwide collector interest for more than 100 years later. In previous years, it was thought that Erdman and Reinhold Schlegelmilch were brothers, but the genealogical research by Berndt Hartwich of Germany and R. H. Capers, USA, clarified this relationship.

A brief history of Germany during the life of the E. S. factory was presented. It spanned the German nation-building period under Bismarck, World War I, the post-war depression and inflation period, and the rise of the Third Reich. It was stated that this turbulent time must have had a dramatic affect on the relatively small porcelain factory that developed, grew and then suffered during the unification of the German states, the industrial revolution, a devastating war, inflation, labor shortages, import embargoes, market condition changes and impending totalitarianism. By 1935, the E. S. factory closed down.

During the factory's operation, numerous distinctive styles were produced. Some styles and marks overlapped, with some of the marks, such as the Prov. Saxe mark, being used over several decades. Other marks are considered to be "ambiguous", and are seen on E. S. china but may have been retailers' marks or limited production items. Many mysteries abound with E. S. marks and china.



To best understand and date the styles, periods of production and the relevant marks, four categories of E.S. porcelain were defined:

- 1) Early Years - Victorian style, with hand-painted abstract designs.
- 2) Neoclassic – Mythological and romantic figural decors
- 3) Art Nouveau – Fancy molds, gilding, scroll work, often with portraits or figural decors
- 4) Art Deco – Smooth shapes with stylized flowers

Generally, the styles and décor produced by the E. S. factory correlated with those produced by the R. S. (Reinhold Schlegelmilch) factory.

The Early years were characterized by hand-painted, surreal designs. The marks most associated with china of this period are the E.S. script marks, and the chicken and “Suhla” mark. Many of the early items are very distinctive and unique. Individual items were not likely mass-produced. In some instances, a tapestry finish was created for these items.

The Neo-classic style comprises of highly ornate molds with Roman and neo-classic motifs. Art work by Swiss artist Angelica Kauffman was used. The Prov. Saxe mark is often seen on these pieces.

The Art Nouveau style is exemplified by ornate shapes, allegorical and romantic styled portraits, gilding and beading. The Lady with Doves motif is one example, and the marks include the Royal Saxe, Prov. Saxe, beehive, and many “related” marks, including EZ Clermont,

Royal Witten and Royal Windsor.

The Art Deco items are similar to R. S. Germany pieces. Stylized flowers and smooth shapes are typical for these pieces. E. S. also did a series of birds on branches and American Indian portraits.

Numerous examples of the various E. S. series were shown. These included: Kauffman neo-classic pieces; goddesses (sea, wind, fire, earth); the crowned portrait series; the Mueller portrait series (women with large flowers in their hair), and examples of the Lady with Doves and Lady with Peacock items.

There is certainly a great interest in E. S. china among the club members, and this “related china” to R. S. has traditionally been associated with and considered to be genuine Schlegelmilch china. In fact, it’s the original Schlegelmilch china, since it pre-dates the R. S. china by eight years. Contributions of pictures by the Rothrocks helped make this presentation thorough and interesting, and the audience participation provided many new and thought-provoking ideas. During the presentation, Gary Marshinski brought a unique cornucopia style centerpiece (shown in the last Newsletter) that has a tapestry finish and a Cupid or angel style figurehead. This item confirms that beautiful E. S. pieces still continue to be discovered.

## Nothing in Life is Free, Part 1

How many times have you heard that phrase or used it yourself? Well it's true, especially in my case with RS Prussia.

Let me tell you about my first and "free" piece of RSP. A friend and colleague of mine, Pat Garrity, knew that I liked and had a few antiques. As I was such an expert (ha! ha!) she asked me to come to her home and look at an antique bowl that she had inherited from her mother. She wanted to know if it was of any value. She suspected that it was as her mom collected a number of different types of very nice antiques.

When I went to her house she proceeded to take a stack of bowls out of her buffet. There were four bowls, all nested together. The top two were Wal-Mart type serving bowls, as was the fourth or bottom one. The third bowl in the stack was the one Pat wanted me to look at. Did I mention that one bowl was stacked on top of the next with no protection between bowls?

Click, clack, clink went the bowls as Pat separated them. When she got to the third bowl my eyes opened wide. There it was, one of the most beautiful bowls I had ever seen and big too. It was twelve inches in diameter. It had a white, pastel orange and pastel lavender background with beautiful pink and red roses in the middle. The bowl itself was molded like flowers and it had a silky feel or finish to it.

I knew this was not an ordinary bowl and that it must be very special. I really didn't know much about RSP, just that it was a beautiful and fine type of porcelain that typically had a mark on the back called the wreath or red mark. At this point I was very excited and couldn't wait to turn the bowl over. Sure enough, it had that red mark.

I told Pat that this was a very fine and expensive bowl and then scolded her for nesting the bowls with no protection between the

bowls. She promised to treat the bowl with more respect and to be careful with the way she stored it. She told me that to her it was "just a bowl" and that she did not care for antiques and had no interest in collecting them.

When we parted, the bowl was sitting alone on top of the buffet. Whew! I promised Pat that I would see what I could find out about the bowl and even a value if possible.

On my next trip to the Wisconsin Dells, I took a picture of the bowl to an antique shop that was run by a very nice man. I had visited his shop on my previous trip to the Dells and I remembered that he had many fine and beautiful antiques. I bought a beautiful German luster cup and saucer as that was all I could afford at the time.

I described my friends bowl as well as showing a picture of the bowl to him and he told me that it was in fact RSP. The mold was the carnation mold and it felt silky because it had a satin finish. He said it was worth 250 – 300 dollars.

I was amazed at the price and that it was such a fine piece. This nice man then proceeded to take a number of RSP bowls and plates out of the cabinets and explained what they were and their value. Wow, this was all so amazing and I had such fun touching and feeling all this expensive porcelain. The shop keeper knew I wasn't going to buy any RSP but was so patient with me and taught me so much.
